

# The Relationship Between Good Works and Salvation

1	Salvation is <b>NOT BY WORKS</b> (Ephesians 2:8-9)	Salvation is <b>UNTO GOOD WORKS</b> (Ephesians 2:10)
2	Good works are <u>not</u> the <b>MEANS</b> of salvation (Titus 3:5).	Good works are the <b>RESULT</b> of salvation (Titus 3:8).
3	Good works are <u>not</u> the <b>CAUSE</b> of salvation.	Good works are the <b>CONSEQUENCE</b> of salvation.
4	Good works are <u>not</u> <b><u>what a person must do to be saved.</u></b> "But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness." (Rom. 4:5).	Good works <b><u>are what a saved person does.</u></b> "This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds. These things are good and profitable for men." Titus 3:8
5	The <b><u>unsaved person</u></b> performs good works to try to obtain and merit God's favor.	The <b><u>saved person</u></b> performs good works because he has obtained God's favor (Titus 2:11-14).
